

2014 MadoroM Camouflage Napa Valley Proprietary Red Blend

Technical Notes:

- 58% Cabernet Sauvignon, 32% Merlot
- Aged 23 months years in a mix of French Oak barrels and American Oak
- Bottled October, 2015
- 14.7% Alcohol
- Unfined

Winemakers Tasting Notes:

Inky purple center and rim is your first indication the wine is serious. The aromas are like you are standing over a stove of black and red berry fruits being simmered to create preserves. Swirling provides dusted mocha and marzipan to the complexity.

Your mouth starts to water just a bit as you get ready for your first sip. The well-defined legs introduce themselves to your palette and broadly fill all the nooks and crannies. Mulberry juice with trailing framboise candy dance and linger. Sweet notes hold a chorus and keep the weighty mix fulfilling flavors for a long time.

Hints of toasted almond and earthy meadow expand the profile. The wine is soft initially and concentration of flavors will reward additional cellaring. Of course any occasion is a great excuse to share with friends and family. Cheers!
