

2016 Madorom Camouflage Napa Valley Rosé

Technical Notes:

- 100% Cabernet Sauvignon from Napa Valley
- Fermented in stainless steel
- Bottled February 2017
- 14.1% Alcohol

Winemakers Tasting Notes:

This is the inaugural Camouflage Rosé. It was made from Cabernet Sauvignon grapes and fermented cold in stainless steel to preserve the fresh fruit aromas and flavors.

Pale pink color is followed by strawberry and cranberry aromas. The flavors mimic the aromas and are elevated by a slight petulance. The wine is totally dry and there is enough acidity to hold red raspberry in the finish.

The wine will accompany a wide variety of appetizers from grilled fruit and entrees such as barbequed salmon. The sun captured in the glass will brighten up any gathering of friends and family. Salute!
